

Centralised actions 2024 – Policy Experimentation

Deadline: 4 June, 17.00 CET

General eligibility (as coordinator or partner): Applicants must be legal entities (public or private bodies) active in the fields of education and training, research and innovation or in the world or work. Their institutions need to be established in Erasmus+ programme countries (EU-member states or non-EU countries listed as EEA-countries or associated to the programme).
