


Submitted proposals by coordinator country (2022 and 2023)

Darker colour = more projects




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Capacity Building in VET - call 2023 **162 Applicants – submitted projects**






Applicants - Call 2022 – 121 submitted projects



EU Member States & Third countries associated to Programme

Applicants from 28 countries submitted proposals in the CB VET 2022 call. 20 EU Member States are represented among the applicant organisations. Not represented are Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxemburg and Slovenia. Organisations from 5 third countries not associated to E+ have submitted proposals. With 29 coordinating organisations, Italy is well represented among the applicant countries, followed by Greece (13), Germany (9) and Spain (9).
