
- Since 1997:
 Strong collaboration of 13 universities with the rofile
 - Mobility of students, support staff and researcher
 - Problem-based learning methodologies
 - Joint educational programmes
 - European Educational and Research Projects
- 2017: Need for (a European approach) towards systemic change in Higher Education.
- 2019: Official launch of ECIU
 University with the aim to have
 a transformative and long term impact on society.
- How? By connecting the ecosystem and training Students and Continuous Learners jointly across Europe via flexible learning pathways.

Student Council & Student Ambassador self organisation in ECIU governance model



Each partner university selects 1 representative from the local Student Union to participate in the **ECIU Student Council.** The **Student Council** elects two students to the **ECIU Board**. Student Board Members have equal voting power in the ECIU Board.

The **Student Council** sends delegates to the **Steering & Implementation** groups, including IT Steering Group, Digital Experience Steering Group, Vice Presidents Education.

Each partner university annually selects 2 students from the local student body to participate as **Student Ambassadors**. The **Student Ambassadors** participate in the **operational** groups, including Institutional Education Teams, Learner Engagement Focus Groups and User Experience Focus Groups.

Governance at the Institutional Level (UT example)

Governing & Executive

The Rector is end responsible for ECIU at UT.

Steering

Deans of Faculties, faculty Vice Deans of Education, faculty International Offices

Implementation

The Programme Management Team oversees the implementation of ECIU at UT. The PMT is chaired by the Institutional Coordinator.

Operations

The ECIU Office (all work package & working group liaisons) embed goals & structure of ECIU within UT. The Institutional Coordinator oversees and reports on all operations.

The Institutional Coordinator and is active member in all governance levels.

Criteria for Success

ECIU Governance:

- Clear communication and decision-making lines
- Organization in Transition: From network to building a joint European umbrella organization
- Additional investments and dare to take risk: Return on investment or return on innovation?
- Balance Institutional needs and the needs of the ECIU
 University: Constant need for Strategic Alignment
- Level of Steering/Enable bottom-up initiatives and allow communities to flourish
- Balance out and accept different speeds, way of working and expectations.

Institutional Governance:

- Always take the larger university community along in institutional decisions
- Ensure clear responsibilities and roles
- Communication is key!
- Integrate opportunities into the university curriculum
- Ensure students and external partners remain engaged and interested in offer
- Make champions out of past students and Teamchers
- Embedding strategy takes time create space for teachers, and support staff to adjust.
- Sustainability is a key factor to success
