Engaging with your stakeholders



Systematic approach

- Identify (who)
- Analyze (understanding them and knowing how best to involve them)
- Plan and implement actions (share information, gain insights, increase support)
- Leading to support, information to further shape the project, reduces the potential for conflict, enhances the reputation










Engagement of Primary stakeholders

- Community meetings (2 per yr)






Engagement of Leadership

- Active (steering) role in consortium activities






Stakeholder Researchers
