Bologna Implementation Report

Preliminary data

Treat these data with caution – based on national reports, clarifications might be needed!

- 19 systems state that the EA is permitted by their legislative framework...
- 22 systems state that the EA is not permitted.
- 6 systems state that the EA is not applicable to their QA system

Planned changes in legislation

- Only 9 countries claim to have plans to change their legal framework to permit the EA.
- However, 8 of these country reports do not contain information on concrete plans.

Cooperation EAC – EACEA – E4 + EQAR

- EACEA events – awareness raising
- Sharing information
- Clarifying terminology
- Understanding different perspectives
- Supporting HEIs
- Follow-up

Conclusions last meeting EAC – EACEA – E4 + EQAR

- Further awareness raising needed
- Review EACEA call documents
- Involving each other in relevant meetings with stakeholders
- Support to potential applicants facing problems
- Regular exchange to review progress
